RESIGNATION

The council was presented a letter from member Stefan Schoenfelder with his resignation from the City Council. A motion was made by Schlosser, seconded by Caudillo to approve the resignation, all voted in favor and the resignation was approved. The council asked Mayor Triepke to propose an appointment for the open council seat at a special meeting on July 16.

GOLF CART ORDINANCE

City Attorney Radermacher presented language for a new golf cart ordinance. Motion was made by Sitzmann, seconded by VanEnk to approve the first reading of the ordinance, with changes as discussed. All voted in favor on a roll call vote. Second reading will be at a special meeting on July 16.

CITY PROPERTY

With the moving of Sanford Clinic, the city no longer has use for the building at 506 Main St. Motion was made by Sitzmann, seconded by Caudillo to deed the building to the Edgeley JDA as is precedented for commercial property. All voted in favor on a roll call vote. Attorney Radermacher will prepare paperwork for the transfer of ownership to be completed on August 1, when the lease with Sanford expires.

MOSQUITO SPRAYING

Resident Wayne Henderson had emailed the council suggesting the timing of mosquito spraying be adjusted for better efficacy. After discussion, it was determined that no changes needed to be made to current practice. Council asked Auditor Irey to send alerts to the community to alert them to spraying times in advance.

PERMIT APPROVALS

Motion by Sitzmann, seconded by VanEnk to approve the building permit for James Steele.

OTHER BUSINESS

Attorney Radermacher presented an ordinance regarding public comment at meetings to bring the city in compliance with new legislation effective August 1. Motion was made by Caudillo, seconded by Schlosser to approve the first reading of the ordinance with no changes. Second reading will be at a special meeting on July 16.

Rates for commercial water filling were discussed, as that was not part of the utility resolution. Motion was made by Schlosser, seconded by Sitzmann to establish a rate of \$50 per fill, including up to 2,000 gallons of water. Anything over 2,000 gallons will be charged as a separate fill at a rate of \$50 per 2,000 gallons.

Mayor Triepke adjourned the meeting at 7:12 pm.
