ALUMNI AND SUMMER EVENTS

Motion by Caudillo, seconded by Schoenfelder to donate \$400 to pay for the band at the Fire Department chicken feed, \$1500 to help the Lions cover expenses for SummerFest events, and an undetermined amount to cover the cost of portable toilets for Main Street during Alumni weekend. All present voted in favor on a roll call vote, motion carried.

BANNERS FOR MAIN STREET

Motion by Schlosser, seconded by Koenig to order 17 new banners to be hung on street light poles. All present voted in favor on a roll call vote, motion carried.

UTILITY BILLING UPDATE

Irey reported that the utility billing account transfer has begun and next month's billing will be done in the new system. Inactive accounts for Napier, Watkins, and DaFonte will be written off and not carried over into the new system.

PERMIT APPROVALS

Building permits were presented for Arnie Middlestead, Joe Neis, and James Steele. Motion was made by Schlosser, seconded by Schoenfelder to approve all building permits. All present voted in favor on a roll call vote, motion carried.

Motion by Schoenfelder, seconded by Caudillo to approve a late close permit for Bottom's Up to close at 2AM on Saturday, June 21 (Friday night). All present voted in favor on a roll call vote, motion carried.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mayor Triepke presented information on a street sweeping service contract as an alternative to purchasing a new sweeper. Motion by Schoenfelder, seconded by Schlosser to contract with ProSweep to provide street sweeping services at a cost \$4,700 per sweeping. All present voted in favor on a roll call vote, motion carried.

Bids were presented for various street update and repair projects. Motion by Schoenfelder, seconded by Koenig to approve patching as needed (contingent upon price confirmation with bid), but make no major street repairs at this time. All present voted in favor on a roll call vote, motion carried.

Mayor Triepke adjourned the meeting at 6:49 pm.
